WOODBURY- Flanders Nature Center & Land Trust is pleased to announce that Sarah Harris was the winner of the Finding Cubby Contest. While exploring Flanders Van Vleck Farm Sanctuary on Flanders Road in Woodbury, Sarah was the first person to discover Cubby the bear.

Our founder Natalie Van Vleck gifted the 200 acre farm to the community in 1968. Flanders now manages close to 2000 acres of open space. Flanders encourages everyone to get outside, take a hike and enjoy the great outdoors. Flanders Nature Center & Land Trust is a nonprofit organization that focuses on environmental education, and on the acquisition, conservation, and stewardship of open space. Through its land trust initiatives, Flanders actively works to protect important natural sites and the area's landscape character and quality of life. Educational programs for children and adults are offered at the Van Vleck Farm Sanctuary, Flanders' main campus in Woodbury. Trails at its major nature preserves are open to the public at no charge from dawn to dusk.
