On the Family Fun Egg Hunt, families will see what hatches from eggs at Flanders from the farm to the meadow and will visit with live rabbits. The egg hunt will be held on Sunday, March 16 from 1 to 4 PM at the Trail House, located on Church Hill Road in Woodbury. The program fee is \$10 for member families and \$20 for nonmember families. Space is limited so pre-registration is required.
