**Flanders to Host “Farm Day” Celebration on Saturday, May 16**

**Woodbury** - Flanders Nature Center & Land Trust will host a Farm Day Celebration on Saturday, May 16 from 1 to 4 PM. It will feature farm and garden-related activities for the whole family.

There will be live farm animals; tractor rides; gardening talks and planting tips; fiber arts demonstrations featuring llama, alpaca and sheep wool; beekeeping basics; kids crafts and story time; live entertainment; outdoor cooking demonstrations food for sale, and The Buz Russell Museum of Antique Farm Tools & Rural Life will also be open.

Activities will be held in and around the North Barn and Community Garden. Parking will be available at Flanders main entrance at the junction of Flanders and Church Hill Roads in Woodbury.

charge from dawn to dusk. Flanders Welcome Center is located at the corner of Church Hill and Flanders Roads in Woodbury.
