## **Flanders to Offer “Batty” Presentation**

The lecture will consist of a power point presentation by Dan Denslow, a junior at Nonnewaug High School. A member of Troop 65 in Oxford, Dan is putting on the presentation as part of his Eagle Scout project on bat ecology and conservation.
