**Flanders Summer Camp Openings**

**WOODBURY** – Flanders Nature Center & Land Trust still has openings in its “Summer Series” camps, which are open to children age 3 to 10. Camps run Monday thru Friday every week until August 22<sup>nd</sup>, with morning and afternoon programs centering on nature, farming, and art.

Conducted by members of the Flanders Education Department and teen volunteers, the camps focus on teaching children about the wonders of nature while allowing them to experience farm life and express themselves through arts and crafts.

By exploring the various parts of the Nature Center, including the pond, fields, and forest, children gain a better understanding of the natural world and their place within it.

Programs include Bug-A-Mania, Pond Life, Incredible Cows, Nocturnal Animals, Young Biologists, Woolly Wonders, Nature Detectives and more.

Registration and pre-payment are required. For ages 3 - 4, members pay \$85 and nonmembers pay \$110 per child. For ages 5 -10, members pay \$100 and nonmembers pay \$125 per child. A 10% discount is given if a child takes multiple classes.
